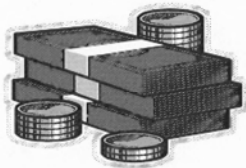
The weekday School Mass will be Friday, September 3rd at 8:15 a.m. The Mass will be hosted by Mr. Stintman's 8th Grade Class.

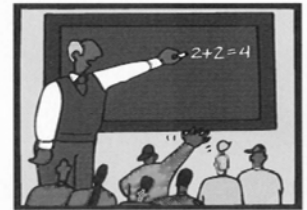
Sponsor – A - Student

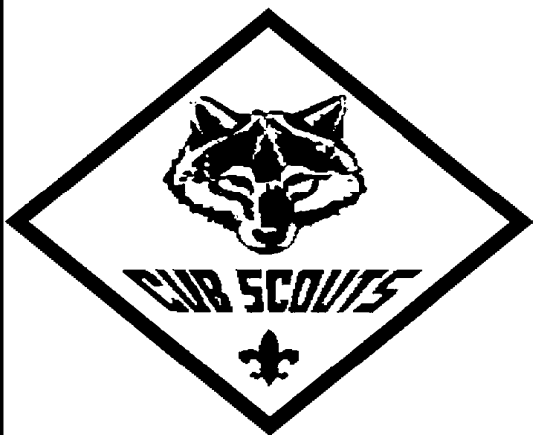
